



## **Privacy Statement**

Farmgate Cocoa Alliance (FCA) is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. Our Statement of privacy applies to the FCA manage data collection and usage. By using the FCA website, your permission to the data practices described in this statement.

FCA collects personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, home or work address and telephone number. FCA also gathers anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as ZIP code, date of bed, gender.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by FCA This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. FCA is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on web sites outside of the FCA and FCA affiliated web sites.

## **Personal Information**

FCA collects and uses your personal information to operate FCA website and to deliver the services you have requested. FCA also uses your personally identifiable information to inform you of other activities or services available from FCA and its affiliates. FCA may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

FCA does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. FCA will contact you on behalf of external activities from partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you an FCA. Should in cases your personally identifiable data (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party.

FCA may share information with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries.

All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to FCA and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

FCA does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.



FCA keeps track the websites and pages our customers visit within FCA in order to determine what FCA services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within FCA to customers whose behaviour indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

FCA websites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (1) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on FCA or the site; (2) protect and defend the rights or property of FCA and, (3) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of FCA website.

### **Cookies**

FCA website use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. Cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Youth Advocate Programs, Inc. pages, or register with Youth Advocate Programs, Inc. site or services, a cookie helps FCA to recall your specific information on subsequent visits.

This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the FCA features.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the FCA services and websites you have visit.

### **Personal data security**

FCA will secures your personal data from unauthorized access, use or disclosure FCA secures the personally identifiable data you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure.
